Applications for the scholarship are invited from emerging leaders (up to 30 years old) in the Hunter region who aspire to make a difference, contribute to the community, challenge the status quo, and actively participate in the HunterNet Future Leaders Program community. Applicants must submit a letter of application addressing key criteria, including the meaning of participating in the program, aspirations, past and future career goals, leadership development through overcoming challenges, and the significance of the region's heritage in promoting positive change and innovation.



#### **Assessment Criteria:**

- Emerging leader (up to 30 years old) from the Hunter region.
- Aspirations to become a future leader across any industry.
- Commitment to making a difference in the region and the community.
- Willingness to take risks and challenge the status quo.
- Commitment to hard work and active participation in the HunterNet FLP community.

#### **Application Requirements:**

- Letter of application addressing specific criteria.
- Demonstration of aspirations and how financial and moral support will contribute to education and personal development.
- Outline of past and future career goals and their impact on leadership skills and business environment.
- Discussion of past, present, and future challenges, and their role in leadership development.
- Reflection on the heritage of the region and its integration with necessary change, innovation, and progression.

**Application Deadline:** Applications close on Friday, 13th February 2026. With Interviews to commence from 20<sup>th</sup> February. All applicants must be available to commence the Program the 5th of March 2026.
